



On-Site Child Care Services

We are excited to offer on-site child care services to our clients. We understand that it can be difficult to find someone to watch over the little one's while you attend short-term health appointments. Therefore, we made a commitment to create a space that would allow children to have a safe place for active fun while their caregivers focus their attention on their own health and wellness.

Our child care service is geared toward children whom are 6 years of age or younger.

However, older children are welcome to attend. In order to use our services, the caregiver or parent(s) must be attending an appointment at Aspirations Inc. and are required to remain on the premises. Registration of your child is mandatory to use the service, so we suggest that you arrive early to complete the required documentation.

Hours of Operation

Clients can request the use of the on-site child care services upon making their appointment with their therapist. If this service is not requested at the time of booking an appointment, Aspirations Inc. cannot guarantee the availability of this service.

Cost of Service

The service fee is \$5.25 /child/hour

Infants: Activity mats, bouncy chair, play-center, jolly jumper, swing, various toys & infant books

Nursery for sleeping/napping & feeding

Toddlers: Reading Books, colouring, puzzles, puppet play, interactive games & toys, play-dough, crafts & videos

Child-to-Staff Ratio

Aspirations Inc. follows the child-to-staff ratio guidelines set by the Alberta Government for drop-in daycare centers.

5:1 Newborn to 19 months 8:1 19 months to 3 yrs 10:1 3 yrs to 5yrs

Policies & Procedures

Parents are required to complete a waiver form for each child on the first visit and are required to sign in and out each child on each visit. Payment for service can be made to Aspirations Inc. in form of cash or cheque. Payments are made to your therapist at the time of your session. Aspirations Inc. reserves the right to turn away children to maintain ratios; a child is sick; or disruptive.
